I am a Coach because I want our kids' baseball experience to be something special.....something they will always remember because they had a great time & they learned something about life through baseball.

The kids only have fun when they are learning. Making practice a quality learning experience for 11, 12 or more players is virtually a full time job that I take seriously....so I need to get additional help & resources to do the job right. The other coaches & I need your help too.

I want our Team to go to PV Baseball Community Team Training Center as they have all the resources & a well thought out & successful hitting system with program, to help the Team reach full potential & make this season one they will always remember.

This Training Center has all the resources needed to run a full Team practice more efficiently & effectively than we can possibly run either at the ballpark or at a local batting cage....PLUS, they teach us all....parents, coaches & athletes.....how to use a successful hitting program that can get the entire Team 250, 350 or more QUALITY swings EACH in approximately an hour, through their Step by Step to a Pro Swing system by Coach Preston Peavy of Marietta.

The cost is incredibly low at about \$15 per player (for a 12 man team that equates to 4 to 6 cents a swing) for each very full training session & the Team gets private use of the custom facility during each session, with no interruptions. PV Baseball will teach all coaches & parents how to run their Step by Step Drill Sets in a simple way that will not overwhelm parents that are not baseball coaches, so parents can give our coaches enough help to run the most efficient practice imaginable.....AND they have a custom facility to let us run up to 12 drill stations SIMULTANEOUSLY. No players will have to stand around the whole session long.

Here is how it works:

1. We sign up for 13 Team Sessions that we can do once or twice a week.
 - a. Our coach or team manager will sign up by bank card for a 13 Session Subscription Team Membership at www.pvbaseball.org
 - b. Payments are divided into three automatic payments to make it even more affordable.
 - c. Parents reimburse the coach or manager 3 times at \$65 for each player (12 players) or \$71 each player (11 man team).
 - d. One payment will be at the beginning of training & two more made every 3 or 4 weeks (dependent on if we choose once or twice a week sessions).
2. Coaches, Parents & Players attend a 2 hour Hitting Instruction Orientation Session at PV Baseball.
 - a. We will learn **what** we want to teach
 - b. We will learn **why** we want to teach it
 - c. We will learn **how** we can teach it as a team in a Step by Step to a Pro Swing routine by Coach Peavy.
3. Coaches, Players & Parent Assistants attend the first Private Team Lesson
 - a. PV Baseball will teach us all how to run drill stations that we can easily handle, in about 2 hours
 - b. The drills will help our players build a top swing Step by Step via a proven method
4. Coaches, Players & Parent Assistants attend the second Private Team Lesson
 - a. PV Baseball will add drill stations that we can easily learn in about 1.5 to 2 hrs.
5. Coaches, Players & Parent Assistants attend the third Private Team Lesson
 - a. PV Baseball will be there to help be sure we are running the drills well in about 1.5 hrs.
6. Coaches, Players & Parent Assistants run subsequent Super Sessions once or twice a week for 10 sessions.
 - a. Once the routine is learned, players rip through 250 to 350 or more swings in 1 hr. sessions
 - b. This is the most cost & time effective hitting training we can give our Team.
7. Coach Peavy & his staff are available for occasional team session oversight at additional cost if desired.
8. Subsequent season sessions will add more advanced training items to the drills on a custom basis.
9. Coach Peavy & his staff are available for One on One Lessons at www.peavynet.com at additional cost for those that desire advanced training.
